To: All Customers

From: Henry Meyer, Manager, Kingston Water District

Re: Outside Water Use

Thank you to all of our customers for your historically thoughtful use of water and other natural resources. Your continued efficient use of water has enabled us to supply all you without resorting to outside watering bans.

I do have one small piece of advice: watering during the heat of the day stresses plants and uses far more water than either watering early in the morning or late in the day. Your plants and lawns will receive the greatest benefit by watering during cooler times of the day. Secondly, direct application of water at the base of selected plants will minimize evaporation of water.

The Kingston Water District services the Biscuit City Road area, Tefft Hill, the South Road area north of Curtis Corner Road, Route 108 from Westwind Road north to Rt. 138, much of Old North Road and the adjacent side streets. We also service Upper and Lower College Roads, the Little Rest Road area, Rt. 138 from Rt. 108 west to the Stationhouse Restaurant, and Fairgrounds Road south of Rt. 138.


Re: Water Use
